

Hit the road and discover what local libraries have to offer! This spring, we are partnering with other Illinois libraries across the region to invite you on a special *Library Road Trip* adventure.

From **March 28 through April 30**, all patrons are encouraged to explore participating libraries and experience the unique programs, services, and spaces each one provides to its community. Every library has something different to offer so you never know what you might discover!

To get started, **pick up a Library Road Trip passport at the front desk** and start traveling. Collect a stamp at each library you visit, including your Morris Area Public Library. Make a plan, choose your route, and enjoy discovering libraries throughout the region. Best of all, this event is **free and open to all ages**.

For every new library you visit, you'll receive a stamp and a small souvenir (while supplies last). As you collect stamps, you'll earn raffle tickets toward a **Library Road Trip gift basket**. Morris Area Public Library's gift basket includes **one Family Season Pass to the Morris City Pool**, plus pool toys and accessories courtesy of the City of Morris.

While we'd love for you to visit all 19 participating libraries, any number of stops count. When you're ready to end your journey, simply turn in your completed passport at the front desk. Raffle tickets are awarded based on the number of stamps collected:

- **1–5 stamps** = 1 ticket
- **6–10 stamps** = 2 tickets
- **11–15 stamps** = 3 tickets
- **16–18 stamps** = 4 tickets
- **19 stamps** = 5 tickets

You can find participating libraries on our website. Before visiting each location, remember to check their library website for more information, including hours and any special programs that might be of interest.

**Third Sundays** | 1:00–3:00 PM


*Sensory Sensitive Movie Time*


